



Homework "HMK" (in Agenda) & Reading Homework (below on the 2nd page)

Parents, please go through the web site (pgs. "What We Are Learning" what your child is learning, "Coble News" for all information for the week, "Calendar/Shutterfly") for upcoming events each Monday night.

Monday: Computer Night - Have your child play on the Portaportal Computer Games under **Reading & Language Arts** and/or **Math** for about 20 (or more) minutes tonight.

Tuesday: See Agenda (student written)

Wednesday: See Agenda (student written)

Thursday: Correct any mistakes on papers that came home in **folder (right side)** today. You do not have to return papers. Please keep them. Mistakes will be circled on papers. Please see Grading Rubric w/codes at the bottom of the **Thursday Signing Sheet** on the right side of the **Green Folder**.

Friday: No HMK or you may finish working on Thursday papers if you need to.

There will be a "secret password" found on the Coble News page weekly. Please place or have your child place the password in his/her Agenda Monday Night on the right side of the Agenda in the box. Your child will get a treat for having the password on Tuesday. I change the web site weekly over the weekend. So the password might be up on Sunday. Please **do not** right the password in the Agenda until Monday after school! After you get into a habit of checking the website weekly and having your child do Monday Night Computer HMK, the password will drop (usually after Fall Break). Thanks!



Blue Folder (Reading HMK)

This folder will have your child's reading homework, which will include the following: Reading Log, Take Home Readers (depending on Reading Group), Reading Basil, and Reading Response Journal (may or may not).

Reading Log: This is your child's reading hmk assignment sheet. Please place your child's name & # at the top of the paper. It will have your child's Reading Group Name, Reading Skills (CCS) for that week, daily reading assignments, and a place for you to initial or sign daily/nightly after your child has completed his/her reading hmk. Please initial or sign daily/nightly. The students will be in different reading groups and will have different assignments. So please keep up with your child's work. There may be additional information for your child's Reading Group at the bottom of the Log as well. Please follow any given directions at the bottom. Thanks!

Take Home Reader: A trade book (i.e. Wemberly Worried by: Kenvin Henkes) that will be in the folder or in their backpack if it will not fit in the folder. These books may belong to me, the school, or another 1st grade teacher. **Please return the book the next day unless the assignments are by chapters. Most importantly, books are to be returned in the same condition that they were sent home.**

Reading Basil: This is the first grade reader that is with our school's adopted literature.

Reader's Response Journal: This is a composition notebook that may (depending on Book Club) be in the folder as well. If and when there is a written assignment with the reading for that night, your child will use the Journal as he/she response from the reading, unless there is a sheet given to them to fill out, which will be inside of the Blue Folder as well.

If you see the words "**Your own selection**" that is what your child is to read that night. This will be a reading selection that your child chooses (book from home, favorite book, magazine, and the like). This should read should be from 20 -30 minutes a night (sometimes more depending on the child's reading level). Thank you for your support with the reading hmk.
